**Wednesday evening Bible study** will continue online as well. We will meet online at **7:00 p.m. via our Facebook page**. Handouts for the study will be available via email from the church office. Contact Lisa to get yours each week.

If you don't have Facebook or are unsure how to connect with our Facebook page, contact the church office and someone will be glad to help you. You can also access all of our church information via our website **www.doorwaybc.com**.

**Don't forget to continue your faithful sacrificial gifts to and through the church for our various ministries and those we support.** Even though we're not meeting regularly, our bills and the needs that our budget meets go on and can only do so with your support. You can sign up for online giving on the church website. You can call the church office and ask about giving via text. Or, you can send your tithes and offerings in the mail (don't send cash).

**If you have any needs that we can help meet, don't hesitate to let the church office know.** We have people willing to go shopping for you. Our deacons are ready to help around the house or get you to appointments. Whatever the need, we'll try to meet it. In other words, even when we're not coming to church we can function like the Church.

Again, in effort to protect the health of our church members and submit to guidance of the government as Romans 13:15 counsels, **we will be canceling all corporate gatherings until further notice.** At that time we will reevaluate the situation and make a determination about future gatherings.
